Volleyball

- We are struggling to fill our boys' volleyball tournaments. So far two (7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade) tournaments have been cancelled.
- Discussed the possibility of running a four team tournament vs. a six team tournament in order to generate some revenue.
- Looking at the possibility of rescheduling the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade tournaments with a minimum of four teams.
- Volleyball pictures will take place on Wednesday, September 14<sup>th</sup>.
- Volleyball teams have been set for the season. John Krenz, volleyball coordinator, thought that splits and tryouts went very well. Two criteria (skills and game play) were used for evaluations for A and B teams in the upper grade levels. Suggestions were made by other board members that future evaluations should include both outside evaluators and coach input.

Soccer

- Soccer teams have been set with a total of 10 teams.
- Two coaching clinics were offered for St. Matthias coaches.
- St. John's soccer league will be opening up a K-5 division next year.
- We are in the need of new pinnies.
- Picture day is October 8<sup>th</sup>.
- Soccer awards night will take place in early November.

- Directions for operation and payment for scorers and referees are in place.

Budget
