St. Matthias has been a supporting member of West Central Interfaith for Older Adults since it was organized. Many of our parishioners has benefited from the services offered to help seniors stay in their own homes. Many St. Matthias Parishioners are currently involved as volunteers for Interfaith. There are 13 neighborhood groups serving all of Metropolitan Milwaukee.

S.E.T. Ministry was organized 30 years ago by Catholic Nuns to serve the poorest and most needy in the Central City of Milwaukee. Today S.E.T. (Serve, Empower, Transform) helps grandparents, parents, and children escaped poverty and homelessness by connecting them to resources that can help them train for a good job, secure a home, budget, cook, homemaking skills, healthcare, education, and a multitude of other possibilities.
